ABOUT THE QUOKKA

The Quokka is the richest turf race to be held in Australia outside of Victoria and New South Wales.
The extraordinary prize money of \$5,000,000 is equal to the prestigious W.S. Cox Plate.

Ascot Racecourse in Perth plays host to this exciting event on Saturday 20 April 2024. The brainchild of Racing WA, The Quokka forms part of the world's first-ever tri-code slot series, which includes The Nullarbor for pacers and The Sandgroper for greyhounds. Collectively, this three-day festival injects a substantial boost into the local economy and holds claim to becoming the most anticipated race days for fans.

This race concept draws inspiration from Sydney's The Everest, boasting 14 slot holders, each contributing \$200,000 to select their own contender for the 1200m weight-for-age sprint, open to three-year-olds and older horses. These slot positions can be traded, leased, or even entered into joint ventures before the deadline.

Slot holders identify a horse and then negotiate a prize money-sharing agreement with the horse's owners and trainers. All slot holders signing up in 2024 will commit to a three-year contract.

In 2023, Ascot witnessed the inaugural race, where Overpass, trained by Bjorn Baker, emerged victorious, surpassing WA's superstar mare, Amelia's Jewel from the Simon Miller stable, with the prominent interstate galloper Bella Nipotina, trained by Ciaron Maher and David Eustace, securing the third position.

Australian racing holds an esteemed reputation as the ultimate benchmark for sprinters globally. The negotiations between slot holders and horse connections add an intriguing layer to this relatively young race.

WA's most opulent race day also includes the 'The Joey,' a consolation race where emergency runners for The Quokka are selected. Additionally, the \$500,000 Group 2 Amelia Park Karrakatta Plate for two-year-olds takes centre stage, representing the crown jewel for juvenile racing in the west.

WHAT IS A QUOKKA?

A quokka is a small marsupial native to Australia. It belongs to the macropod family, which includes kangaroos and wallabies. Quokkas are known for their friendly and seemingly smiling facial expressions, which has earned them the nickname "the world's happiest animal." They are herbivorous and primarily inhabit forests and scrublands in southwestern Australia, including Rottnest Island. Quokkas are also a popular subject for wildlife photography due to their charming appearance.



HOW IS THE QUOKKA PRIZEMONEY DISTRIBUTED?

An agreement between the Slot Holder and Owners of their selected animal must be signed and sent to Racing WA. The split of prizemoney is negotiated between both parties until an agreement is reached.

HOW DO HORSES QUALIFY FOR THE QUOKKA?

Horses don't qualify for The Quokka in the traditional way. I.e., winning or placing in ballot exemption races and getting a horse's benchmark or prize money as high as possible.

The Slot Holders are looking to select the best sprinters in Australia or the most promising 'up-and-comers'. It is entirely up to the Slot Holder on which horse they select for their slot.

Performing strongly in races such as the: Group 1 Winterbottom Stakes (1200m), Group 1 Lightning Stakes (1000m), Group 1 Oakleigh Plate (1100m), Group 1 Newmarket Hcp (1200m), Group 1 William Reid Stakes (1200m), Group 1 VRC Classic (1200m) and the Group 3 The Gold Rush (1400m) will likely put in a horse right in contention for a Ouokka slot!



HOW DO I GET MY HORSE TO PERTH?

Racing WA will organise a flight for interstate horses from Sydney to Perth on Monday 8 April 2024 (or near this date).

The Slot Holder will pay approximately AUD 10k each way (Racing WA to offset against prizemoney, per the conditions stipulated by Slot Holders in private arrangement). Racing WA will underwrite the balance of the flight cost from the east coast, so that Slot Holders are not subject to commercial rates.

Where will my horse be stabled?

Racing WA will support all visiting trainers with finding suitable stabling for their horse, whether that is at Ascot Racecourse or in a more rural setting.

When will slot holders be announced to the public?

Monday 13 November 2023.

Who can apply for a slot?

How are emergencies selected?

The Race Committee will, in its absolute discretion, select four eligible horses to be included in the final Emergency Pool for the Race (Emergency Pool). The Emergency Pool will comprise of four eligible horses which will be selected from the pool of horses who have been accepted to race in the consolation race (The Joey) programmed on the same day as the Race (as determined by RWWA)
